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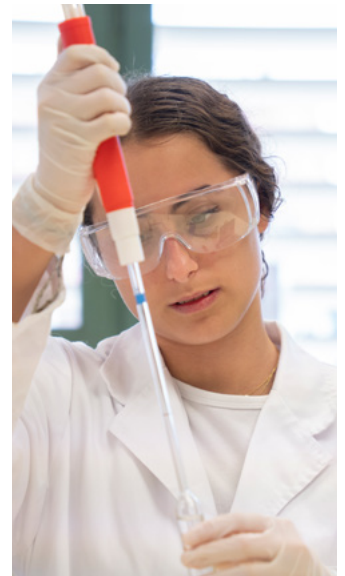
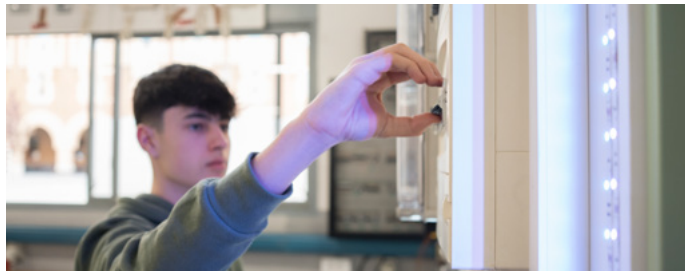

HEADSHIP INTERVIEW

This year, on the bicentennial of the dream Don Bosco had when he was nine years old, the Salesian colleges encourage us to dream with the slogan "A dream for you". What are you promoting with this campaign?

This slogan talks about each person's vocation. Vocation in the sense of an answer to a personal and professional calling. The answer depends on each person's deepest meaning of life itself, happiness and self-realisation. As a Christian college, we believe that God makes this call to each young person, and that each one answers their calling through their life project. Our mission as a college is to accompany the young person in their response and to assist them in their personal and professional advancement.

The rate of satisfaction of companies with your students in Vocational Education and Training, where Salesians Sarrià is the benchmark semi-private school in Barcelona, is very high (90%). What is the key to your success?

The success of Vocational Education and Training as an educational option is based on three cornerstones: first, a totally practical approach of "learning by doing", its flexibility in training pathways and its diverse range of certifications. Second, it is a flexible and multifaceted option that fits in naturally with an inclusive school. The third cornerstone of our success is the ongoing connection with enterprises, as this guarantees a job placement rate that no other educational pathway can equal. Flexibility, practicality and job placement are the three ingredients. We, as a Salesian college, add a fourth component: the profile of our graduating students. We do not merely teach. We educate. This means that our actions are extremely comprehensive and profound.

Our students are young talent that is greatly appreciated by all companies thanks to their excellent technical training, as well as for the habits and the values that we instil in them from the very first day. These values include – and this is a highly distinguishing qualitative trait – a Christian and transcendental view of the world that drives them to make a responsible and transformative commitment to reality and to people. More than 800 of our country's leading companies work with us because this is the kind of profile that they seek for their teams.

Salesians and enterprises, enterprises and Salesians. Your school hosted two important events of the KNX España association, which featured the participation of all the KNX scientific centres from all over the world, besides a huge number of companies from the industrial and technology sector. What did this milestone mean for your college?

The college-company bond is not limited to the working world. For years now, our cooperation with companies has been

based on more far-reaching strategical lines. One of these lines is R&D: our college hosts and implements numerous innovation projects. Another line is our participation in business research and technology transfer networks. This explains our work with the KNX international association and with other business associations.

The college is increasingly more international. Last October you signed a collaboration agreement with two schools from Chile to promote student and teacher mobility. How has this agreement worked out?

Our college's internationalisation and European vocation is clearly rooted in education and culture. We want to prepare young people for a world in which the word "globalisation" should begin to take on a positive meaning: multilingualism, cultural exchange, mobility and adaptation capacity, opening up their horizons for personal and professional growth, learning to look upon life from different angles. Difference, based on dialogue and respect, always enriches us.

Work experience abroad, exchanges, job shadowing, language learning and qualifications, participation in international projects with other schools, supportive projects such as Share, in Zambia, or the recent collaboration agreement with the Fundación Educacional Región de la Minería of Chile, are all the fruit of an accumulation of synergies that we intend to develop even further.

The International Baccalaureate is another doorway into the world for your students, most of whom complete it successfully. If a father, mother or a student is reading this question right now and is uncertain about whether to choose this educational option, what would you tell them?

I would tell them that choosing Salesians Sarrià to do the Baccalaureate is a safe bet. Thanks to the high level of teaching quality, the learning atmosphere and the pastoral education of our Baccalaureate, our students always say that the two years that they spend with us are a highly positive experience that has a decisive bearing on their life. The Baccalaureate and International Baccalaureate are two pathways that cater to two different student profiles. Both of them are magnificent options if they match the young person's interests and capabilities.

In the case of the IB, the profile of these students is one of young and inquisitive people who like to learn and reflect upon what they learn, with personal values that they apply to the academic setting, values to which we as a Salesian college fully subscribe. In any case, any students who are considering this possibility have a personal interview to help them to decide if it is the best academic option for them.

Artificial intelligence is all over the media now, particularly since the advent of ChatGPT. How is your college adapting to all this technological innovation?

We have always looked upon this process as an opportunity for education. AI as a tool is still a work-in-progress with numerous applications in education. We have a team investigating this topic and we publish a regular newsletter for the educational community at large. Moreover, some of our teachers have received extensive training in this area and we

have introduced it into our training plan. What is more, AI and its regulation in the academic setting is being included in all of the school's rules and regulations.

What are the traits that make Salesians Sarrià stand out from other schools?

Our identity is what sets us apart from other schools: we are a Salesian college. Ground-breakers in VET in Europe providing a clear education option for young people. Our ultimate aim is to serve young people. Our educational style rests on five cornerstones. We strive to be a welcoming and safe place where all young people feel that they can realise their full potential as people. We are an inclusive school committed to teaching excellence that will enable all our young people to develop their personal and professional competences to the fullest extent during their stay among us. Our school goes far beyond just the school day: as we aim to offer young people an educational space where they can engage and grow through recreation specifically designed for their age bracket. As a Salesian and Christian college, we embrace the figure of Jesus Christ as one that gives deep meaning to a person's life. By doing so, our proposal, always respecting each and every person's options, is that any person who wants to can develop their spiritual dimension with us. The fifth cornerstone is internationalisation: as a school, we prepare professionals in a multilingual, multicultural and eminently European setting.

PASTORAL EDUCATION PROGRAMME

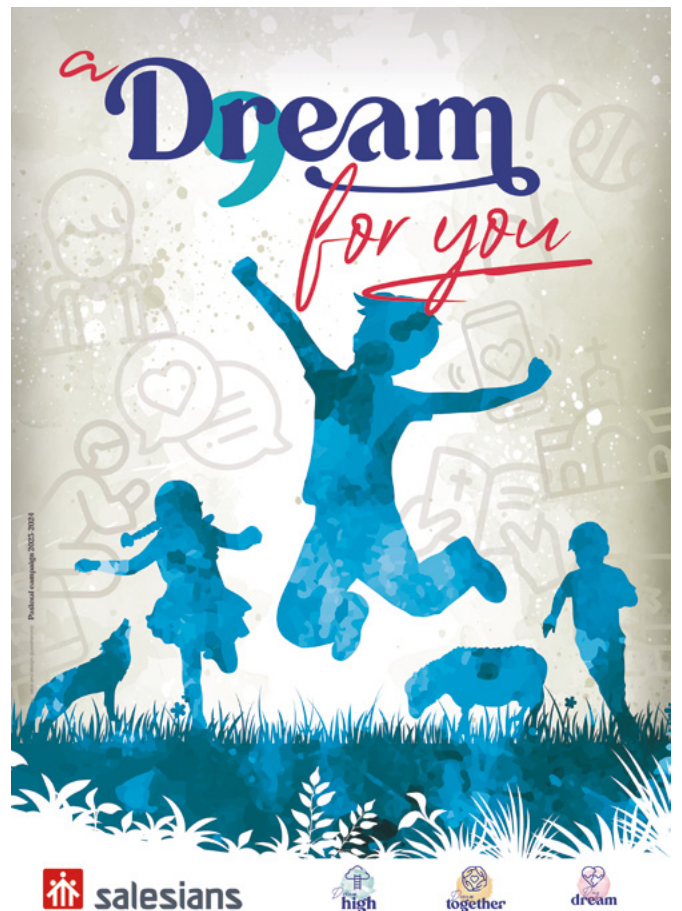

- » We have created a green roof with a surface area of 191 m² that has aromatic plants, a vertical garden, an insect hotel and solar panels.
- » We are members of local and international educational networks that embrace sustainability.
- » We encourage our students to create sustainable projects (see page 13 for examples).

- » We have an Educational Psychology Service (SAPP) for the entire educational community.

- » We organise theme-based workshops such as how to manage stress or healthy couple relationships.

Bosco Global and Fundació Magone

We collaborate with the Salesian NGO Bosco Global to promote a fairer, more equitable and sustainable world through actions in different countries in Africa and South America. On a more local level, we work with the Fundació Magone, an organisation sponsored by the Salesians of the Maria Auxiliadora Inspectorate that works throughout Catalonia and implements projects to help the most vulnerable.



The Bosco Run

On 28 January, we held the eighth edition of The Bosco Run, at which 400 plus runners completed the 5-km run on the streets around our college. An event – which once again this year – was made possible by the support of the participants and 150 volunteers. A genuine example of community spirit!



'Share' International Volunteer Project

In collaboration with the English Farnborough Salesian college and the Daughters of Mary Help of Christians of Zambia, every summer, students and teachers from the college travel to this African country to participate in different aid initiatives for young Zambians.

And not only this, but also through our 'Scholarship Program', our young people can make financial contributions that will help students from that country to study, allowing them to complete their primary, secondary and higher education. Their dreams, like Don Bosco's, also come true!

Sustainable school

Salesians Sarrià encourages a commitment to sustainability among its students, sowing the seeds of a greener and more aware world. And since actions speak louder than words, we are sharing some of the most interesting green projects!

Don Bosco Green Alliance

Salesians Sarrià are part of the international 'Don Bosco Green Alliance' initiative, a project that gets students involved in environmental protection to train a new generation of citizens committed to sustainability.

A 'green lung' in the college

Five years ago, our college started up the 'green roof' as part of the Barcelona City Council's Green Roofs project. We now use this infrastructure as a learning tool for the Higher VET students in Renewable Energies, since it is equipped with photovoltaic solar panels, two wind turbines and a weather station.

ICTA Agreement

Salesians Sarrià has a collaboration agreement with the Institute of Environmental Science and Technology (ICTA) to transfer knowledge and to implement joint actions.



Sustainable waste management

We work actively to implement a circular economy that minimises and improves waste management. One example of this is the use of new drinking water fountains to reduce disposable containers.



We are a UNESCO School

Salesians Sarrià has been recognised by UNESCO as part of its Associated Schools Network. This network is comprised of more than 10,000 schools, and unites more than 180 countries to share values such as sustainability, peace, internationalisation and solidarity.



Sustainable mobility

The environmental challenges of the 21st century call for sustainable mobility. For this reason, we have equipped our facilities to promote the use of public transport or other forms of transport, such as bicycles or electric vehicles, to minimise environmental impact.



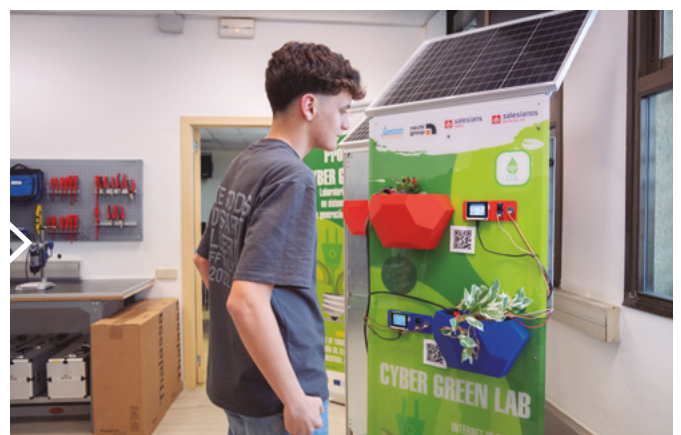
For a city with more trees

Salesians Sarrià has planted trees in the school yard over the last few years, improving air quality in Barcelona and creating a more hospitable space for the community.



Renewable energy through plant photosynthesis

The CyberGreen Lab project, carried out by VET students from our college in collaboration with Salesianos Palma del Río and the companies NechiGroup and Amaysys Technologies, generates renewable energy through a photosynthesis process of the plants installed on a green wall. This initiative comprises different Industry 4.0 facilitating technologies such as artificial intelligence, 3D printing and cybersecurity, and is also aligned with the Sustainable Development Goals.



INTERNATIONAL RELATIONS

We are part of the European Community and we live in a globalised economy. This is why we promote the internationalisation of our educational communities through language-learning, stays abroad, cultural exchanges and associations with schools from other countries.



Small conversation groups

Languages need to be spoken! To encourage the learning of English, French and German, we organise small conversation groups at midday with teachers, most of whom are native speakers. We also provide our teachers with language-training.



Official Cambridge exams

We are an authorised preparatory centre for the official Cambridge exams, a training endorsement for students' academic and employment future. Students can prepare for the First Certificate and Advanced exams with us!



Certified as a multi-language college

Our vocation to internationalise our educational community merited the recognition of the Fundació Escola Cristiana de Catalunya, which was acknowledged through the multilingual college certificate. A stellar recognition and endorsement!



Language assistants

Every year, we host experts in foreign languages who accompany students in their learning process. This year, it was the turn of **Thomas Tarlton**, **Sinem Topsakal** and **Isma Shahid**, who came from the United Kingdom and Türkiye.



ERASMUS+ PROGRAMME

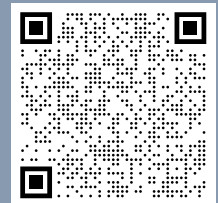
As part of this programme, we hosted several students and teachers from different European schools.

- » Four students and one teacher from the **Don Bosco Technisch Instituut Brussel (Belgium)** are staying at the Motor Vehicle Electromechanics Department.
- » Two students from the **Dvořákovo Gymnázium school**, in the town of Kralupy, near **Prague (Czech Republic)**, are attending the Baccalaureate.
- » Two teachers from the **Byåsen videregående skole**, near **Trondheim** in Norway, visited the Care of Dependent People workshops. We also visited their school to exchange working experiences and methodologies.

INTERNATIONAL PROJECTS

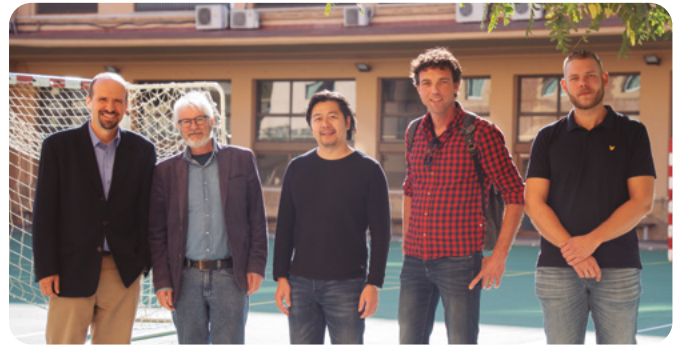
VISIT TO PARTNERS IN THE CZECH REPUBLIC

Our director, **Francisco Álamo**; the head of studies of the Baccalaureate, **Carlos Escriche**; and the head of International Relations, **Laura Ramírez**, visited the **Dvořákovo Gymnázium** school in the town of **Kralupy nad Vltavou**, near Prague (**Czech Republic**). The management highlighted the Czech partners' hospitality and the future collaboration projects that emerged from this meeting.



VISIT BY TEACHERS FROM THE NETHERLANDS

Teachers from the **Dutch Nova College**, as part of the **Jobshadowing Programme**, also visited Salesians Sarrià to share knowledge and experiences with the VET teachers from the motor vehicle and electromechanics, electricity and electronics, renewable energies, and administration specialities. Before this stay, college management had travelled to **The Netherlands**.



EUROPEAN E-TRANSPORT NETWORK

Our college continues to collaborate in the **KA2 European e-Transport Network for VET international project** to set up a European network around the electric vehicle. This year, we participated in an online conference to explain how we teach the electric vehicles subject, and we attended a meeting in **Trondheim (Norway)** in May.



WELCOME TO SARRIÀ!

We were visited by representatives of the **Bridgwater & Taunton College**, in the south of England, to share experiences and good practices in the International Baccalaureate. Moreover, we worked with management and the faculty to plan collaborations and future exchanges between students and faculty of the **Diploma Programme (PD)**.





BARCELONA-BELGIUM CONNECTION

This year we visited the **Sint-Pieters school in Ghent** to learn more about its educational projects and to present the most relevant information from the Erasmus+ 2024-25 Baccalaureate candidacy to them. The management and faculty of Ghent also visited our school. We also received a visit from the Salesian's international coordinator from **Belgium**, who shared mobility-related knowledge and experiences with us.



BACCALAUREATE EXCHANGES

In the Baccalaureate, we work with three schools: **Salesians Farnborough (UK)**, **Duerer-Gymnasium Nuremberg (Germany)** and **Dvořákovo Gymnázium (Prague)**. The first-year Baccalaureate and International Baccalaureate students welcomed the English, Czech and German students who came on a short exchange. The students attended classes and also took part in several recreational and cultural activities. In June, we will travel to their schools and will be staying with their families.

EXCHANGE BETWEEN CHILE AND BARCELONA

We are very happy to have received a delegation from the **Colegio Técnico Industrial Don Bosco Antofagasta** and **Don Bosco Calama** schools here in Barcelona, along with representatives of the **Antofagasta Industrial Association (AIA)**. We enjoyed a week of educational, cultural and business exchanges that strengthened the collaboration we initiated last October. We would also like to mention and thank the **Fundación Educacional Región de la Minería**, which comprises the **archbishopric of Antofagasta**, for having helped to build this highly fertile bridge between continents.

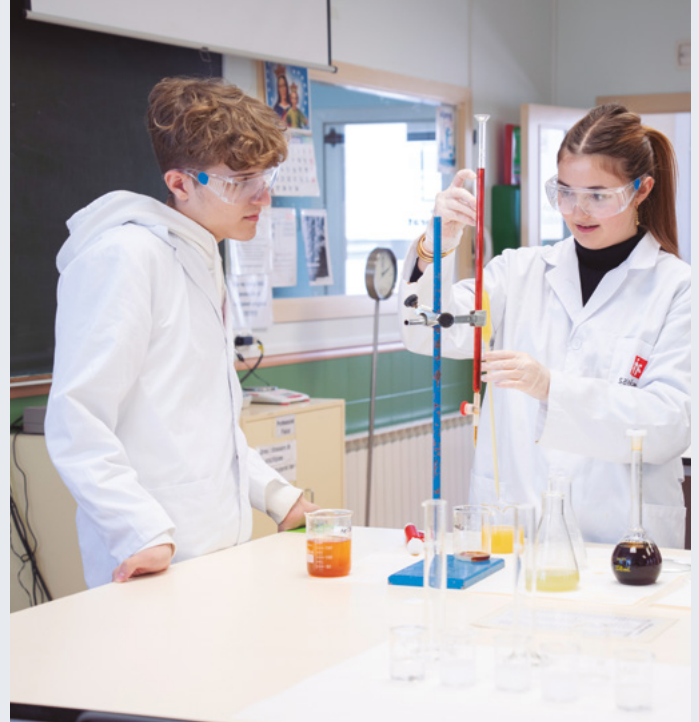

Salesians Sarrià is a college that is officially approved to teach the International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma Programme. These courses, intended for young people between 16 and 19 years of age, are recognised for the Spanish Baccalaureate and for the general university entrance examinations (PAU).

The entrance requirements include having a compulsory secondary education (ESO) completion certificate or its equivalent from a foreign educational system. Pupils who register for this course must pass a selection process and an initial interview, and must also have passed ESO satisfactorily.

A door into the job world

The students get the chance to work in professional settings while they study, which enables them to accrue experience aligned with the demands of the labour market.

Dual Intermediate VET

Students who choose this option acquire the necessary skills to enter the labour market.

Access: the compulsory secondary education (ESO) graduation diploma is required, or passing an examination.
Timetable: Monday to Friday from 8.00 am to 1.30 pm.

Dual Higher VET

Students who complete this modality obtain a technical specialist certification that allows them to enter the world of work with guarantees or to consolidate their professional career.

Access: Intermediate VET, Baccalaureate qualification or entrance examination.
Timetable: from Monday to Friday from 3.30 pm to 9.00 pm.

Academic possibilities:

- University education (direct access) and official recognition of credits depending on their previous study programme
- Any other Higher VET

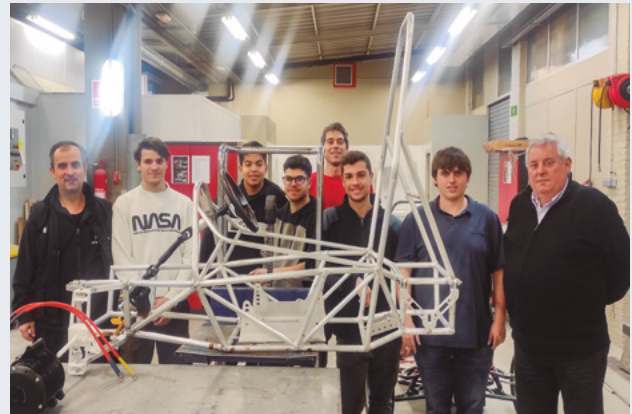
EDUCATIONAL INNOVATION

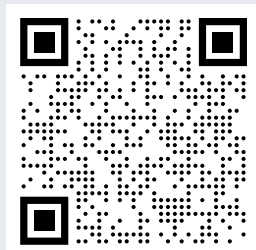


International Baccalaureate

Premio Nacional Don Bosco prize-winners

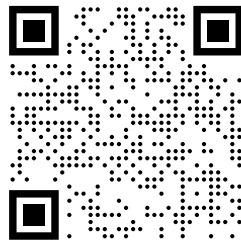

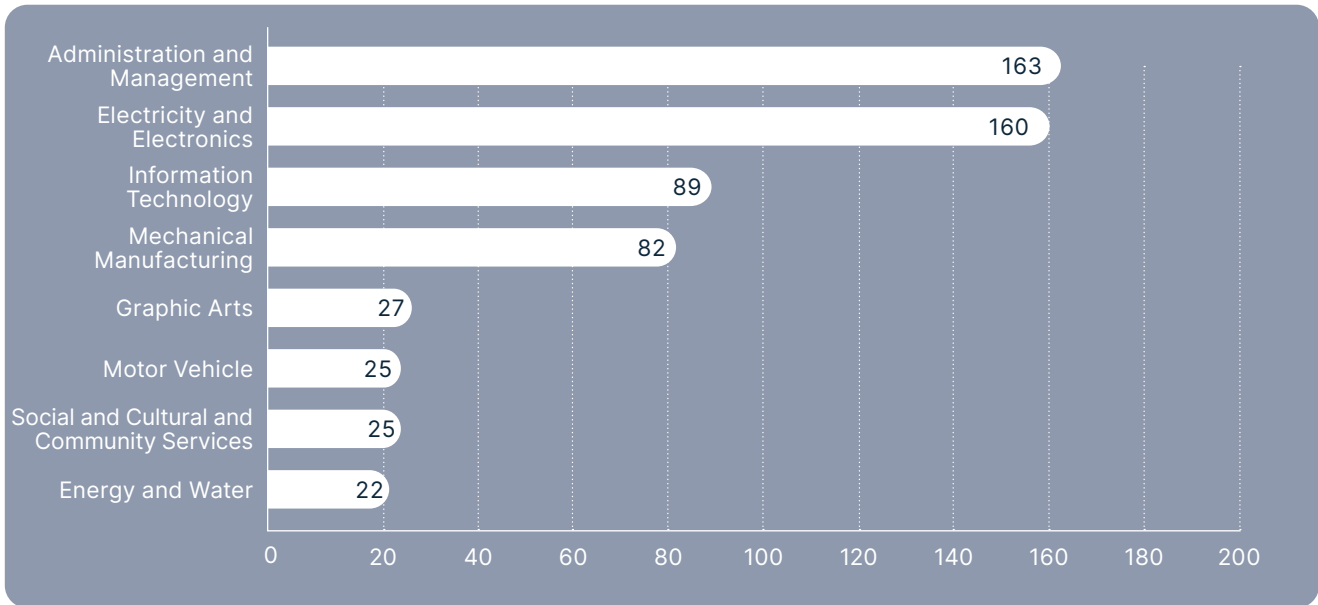

INNOVATION AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP

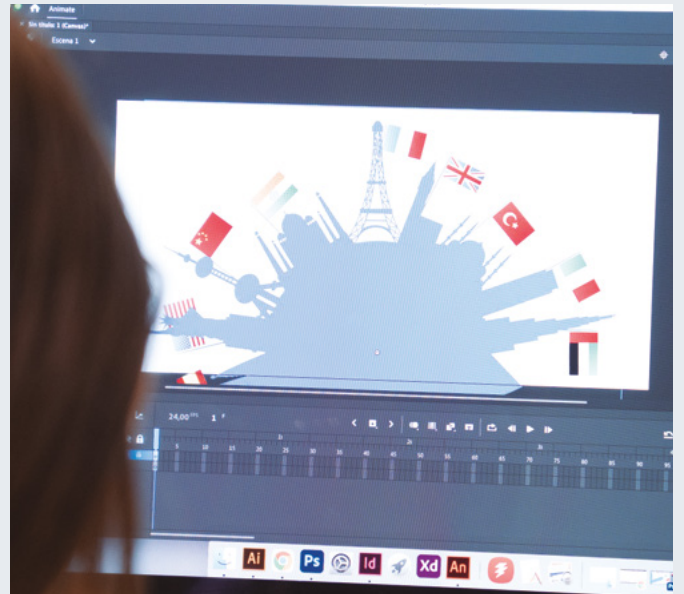

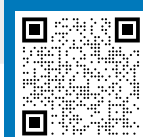

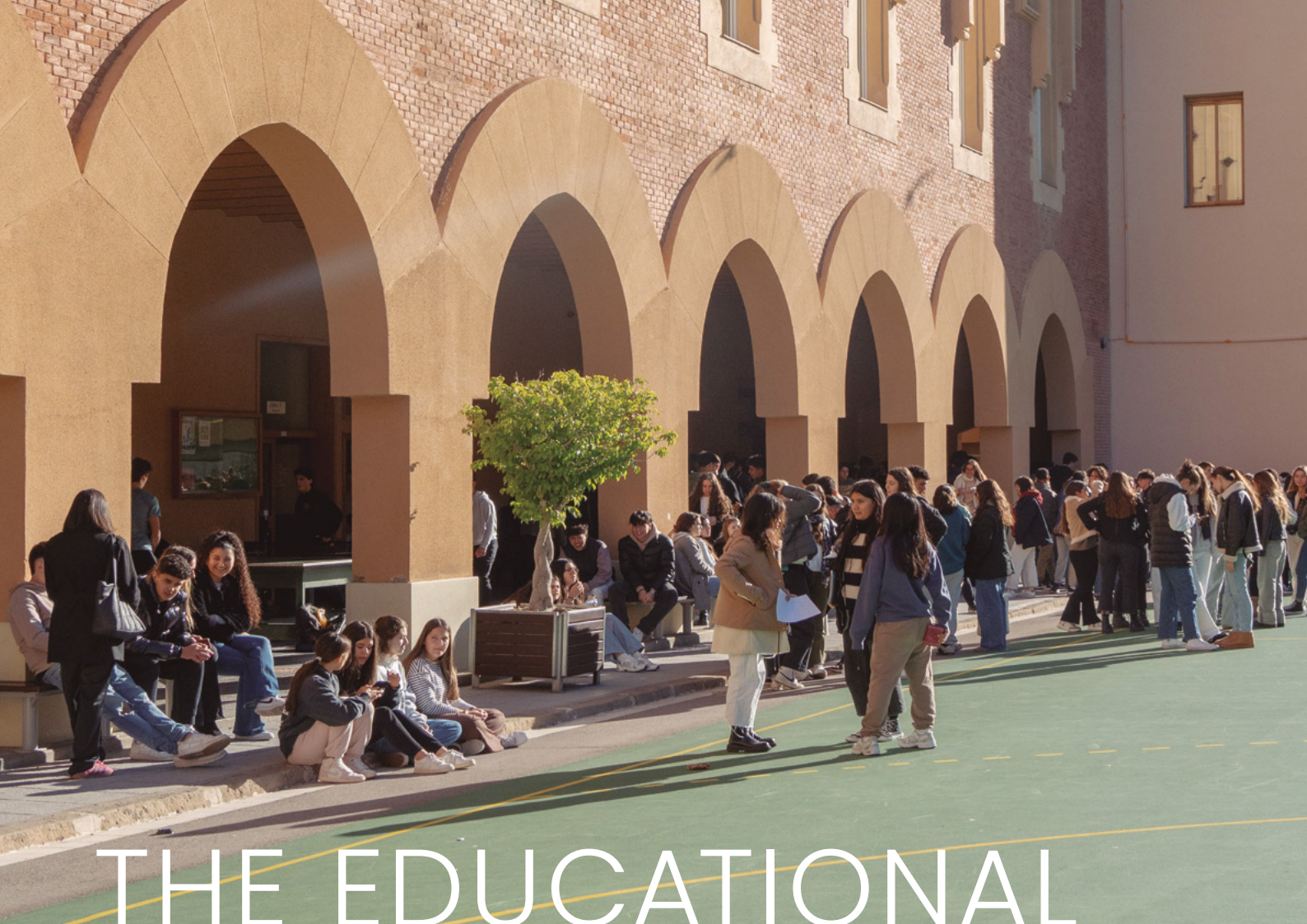

'El IB se dirige a alumnos proactivos, curiosos y con ganas de investigar'

¿Qué ventajas ofrece el IB? A.B.: Es un programa reconocido tanto por los estudiantes que simplifica el acceso a los estudios universitarios en muchos países. 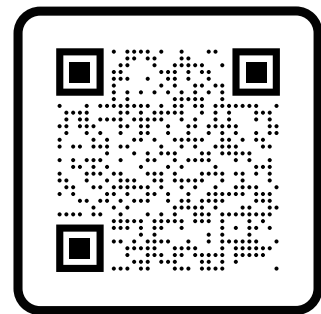

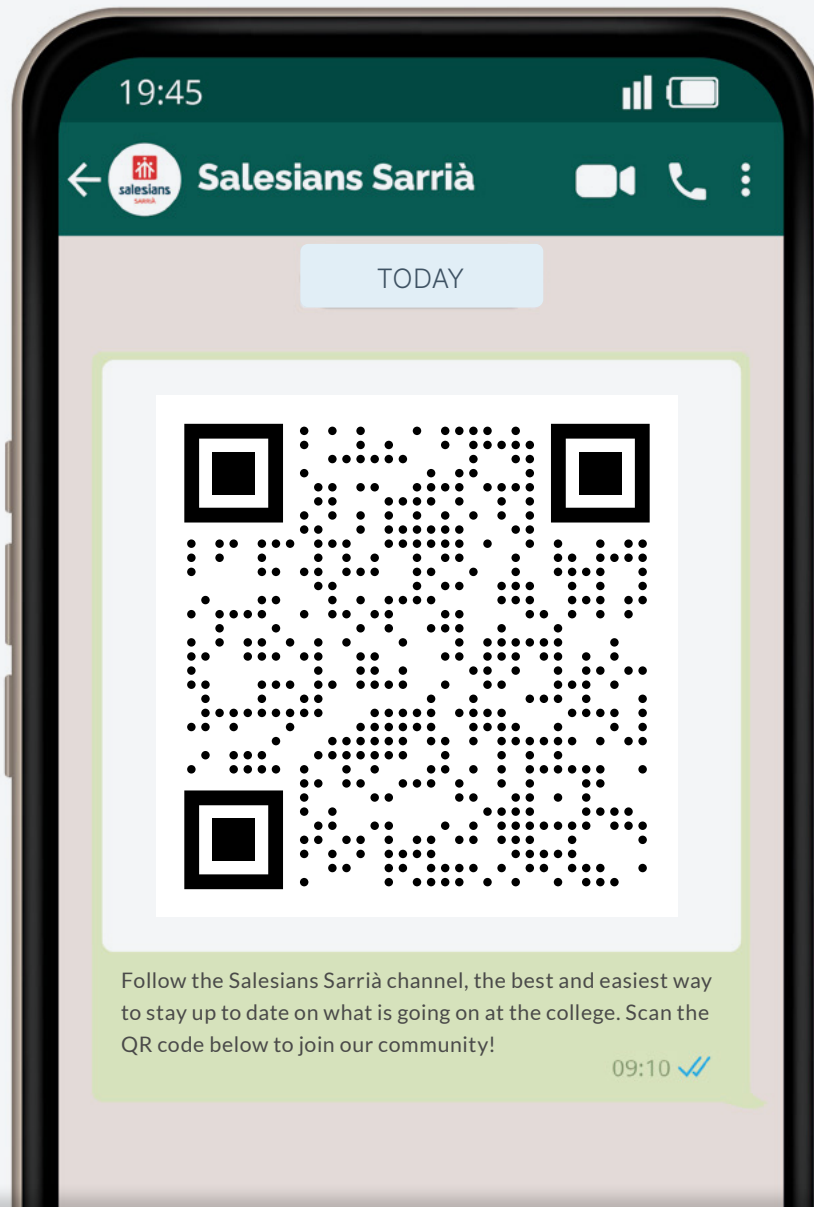

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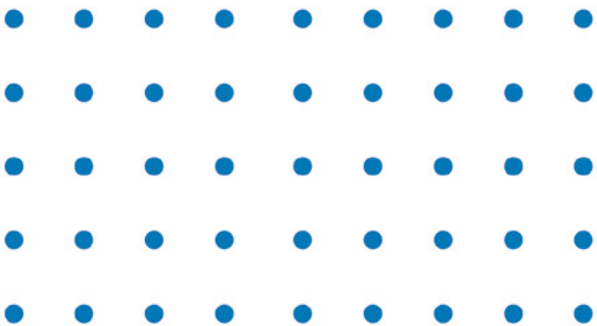
